Goondiwindi was the only SQC region that saw an increase of occupancy during the lockdown that QLD experienced in August.




The Reservation Window for August 2021 is 16 days which is a 27% decrease since last month. When compared to August 2019, it's down by 30%.

Average Occupancy Rate

The occupancy rate is the ratio between the number of occupied rooms and the number of rooms offered that are open.





Reservation Window (days)

The reservation window is the period of time between when the reservation is made by the guests and the actual arrival date to the destination. For example, a reservation window of 36 means that people are booking accommodation on average 36 days before they arrive at the destination.







Length of Stay

Length of stay is the amount of time(days) that was booked at the accommodation.






The average length of stay for August was 3, which is a decrease of 25% from July 2021.

Average Daily Rate

The average daily rate (ADR) measures the average rental revenue earned for an occupied room per day.







The average daily rate for Goondiwindi in August 2021 is \$134, which is an increase of 81% when compared to August 2019. ADR has some excellent growth since the beginning of the year.



These graphs visualise which days of the week people are visiting the most for the month.






INSIGHT

Visitor Segmentation from Brisbane - August 2021




INSIGHT

The top two visitors of Goondiwindi from Brisbane in the month of August were the two wealthiest segments, contributing to 52%. Brisbane was the focus for this analysis as they have the highest propensity to stay overnight.
