

Key Points from August 2020



Lockyer Valley's accommodation occupancy was at 61% in August, a 10% increase year on year.

Figures come from mobility data and includes day trippers, over nighters and people passing through.




41% of visitation to the Lockyer Valley comes from two LGAs, Brisbane and Toowoomba.



Like most of the SQC region, Lockyer Valley continue to perform really well coming out of the covid lock downs.


Across the the region, occupancy has remained strong month on month.





Devices from Toowoomba made up 27.71% of all devices seen in the Lockyer Valley LGA in August 2020.


