

Key Points from May 2021



Toowoomba's Occupancy level for May was 61% and remains the highest among all LGAs for 8 straight months.




Average daily rate has shown great growth into 2021, with a 55% increase from May 2019.



The top two visitors of Toowoomba from Brisbane in the month of April were the two wealthiest segments, contributing to 50% of visitation.

Average Occupancy Rate

The occupancy rate is the ratio between the number of occupied rooms and the number of rooms offered that are open.





Reservation Window (Days)

The reservation window is the period of time between when the reservation is made by the guests and the actual arrival date to the destination. For example, a reservation of 42 days means that people are booking accommodation on average 42 days before they arrive at the destination.





Length of Stay

Length of stay is the amount of time that was booked at the accommodation.






INSIGHT

consistent growth over
the past 4 months.

Average Daily Rate

The average daily rate (ADR) measures the average rental revenue earned for an occupied room per day.







Previous years show a steady trend in the Average Daily Rate, however 2021 has presented some large consistent growth. May 2021 had an ADR of \$115 which was a jump of 55% from 2020.




INSIGHT

These graphs visualise which days of the week people are visiting the most for the month.






The most common days to visit in May 2020 were Thursday and Friday - probably due to COVID. Now into 2021, the most common days are Saturday and Sunday.


