Brisbane to Toowoomba

Approx. 127km / 1hrs 45mins

Depart Brisbane and head west towards Toowoomba where you'll spend 24 hours exploring. Queens Park and the Botanic Gardens are a great way to spend a morning outdoors – grab a takeaway coffee from nearby Burrow Café or indulge in exceptional pastries at The Bakers Duck. Queensland Museum Cobb+Co is great for history buffs. Take a sunset stroll exploring the laneway art walks downtown. Round off the day with a cleansing ale at Bone Idol Brewery in the CBD. Fitzy'offers an extensive list of wines and cocktails, with an excellent dining option. Catch a late show at Empire Theatre where you're likely catch a musical performance, live theatre or dance, or a comedy show as you soak in the lively atmosphere inside this heritage-listed art deco venue.

Toowoomba to Goondiwindi

Approx. 242km / 2hrs 48mins

Take the A39 west to Goondiwindi, visiting Pittsworth 39km south west of Toowoomba, to tour its rich pioneer history at the Pittsworth Pioneer Historical Village. Continue on to Millmerran for the views at Commodore Peak Lookout and then follow the historical mural walk in town. The next stop is Inglewood, where you'll visit the Australian Tobacco Museum and Inglewood Heritage Centre before checking into your accommodation in Goondiwindi

Goondiwindi to Brisbane

Approx. 356km / 4hrs 22mins

Start your day with Goondiwindi Cotton Tours to explore a local cotton farm and the cotton industry of the region, then enjoy a pleasant riverside walk back in town. Stay on the lookout for quirky laneway art and build up your appetite before lunch at the historic Victoria Hotel, heading off to the Yelarbon Silos prior to your return to Brisbane.
