DAY 1:

Brisbane to Ravensbourne

165 km, approximately 1.5 hours
Depart Brisbane and enjoy a scenic drive to Ravensbourne National Park.
Stretch your legs with a rainforest hike and soak in breathtaking views from Gus Beutel Lookout. Head to Crows Nest and explore Nolan's Block, home to eight unique shops, including patisseries and cafés, perfect for a relaxed lunch. In the afternoon, check into Ravensbourne Escape and settle in with a glass of wine on the deck, surrounded by nature. Enjoy a self-catered dinner in the comfort of your retreat.

DAY 2:

Ravensbourne to Toowoomba 50 km Start your day with a leisurely breakfast at The Chocolate Cottage in Highfields. Drive toward Gowrie Junction for a First Nations experience at Gummingurru, one of Queensland's most significant ancient stone arrangements. Enjoy a long lunch at Picnic Point Restaurant, taking in panoramic views over the Lockyer Valley. Spend the afternoon at Toowoomba Carnival of Flowers and wander through Queens Park and Laurel Bank Park, soaking in the spectacular displays and vibrant festival atmosphere. Check in at Potters Hotel, then head to Fitzy's Restaurant, for a flavour-filled dinner.

Overnight: Potters Hotel, Toowoomba

DAY 3:

Toowoomba to Gowrie Little Plain 26 km Start with breakfast at the charming Café Valetta, before visiting the Cobb+Co Museum to explore Toowoomba's rich natural and cultural history. Head north to Meringandan Pub for an authentic Aussie pub meal, famous for its generous portions. In the afternoon, head to Kiambram Country Cottages and settle into your private self-contained cottage to soak in the peaceful countryside. Take a short bushwalk to unwind and then enjoy a home-cooked meal in your cottage.

Overnight: Kiambram Country Cottages, Gowrie Little Plain

DAY 4:

Journey back to Brisbane via the Warrego Highway, enjoying a scenic 1-hour, 50-minute drive.
