

4-Day Itinerary

Brisbane – Western Downs

Step into the authentic Australian countryside, where vast farmlands, animals, and agricultural heritage come together with hearty, traditional meals.

DAY 1:

Brisbane to Lockyer Valley 107 kms

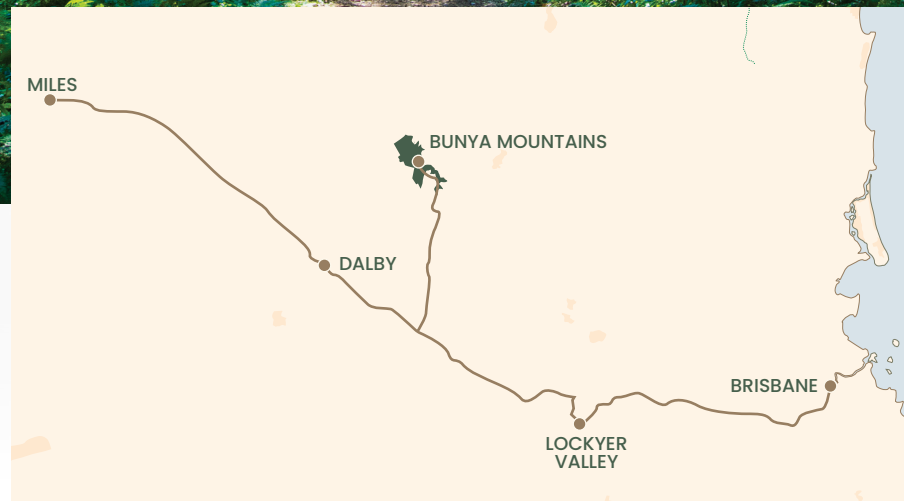
Hit the road via the Warrego Highway, soaking up the rolling countryside as you go. Stop by roadside farm stalls to pick up fresh local produce, perfect for snacking or cooking later. For lunch, tuck into classic Aussie pub fare at the Lockyer Hotel. Check in at Valhalla Glamping, your luxe retreat for the night. Spend the evening unwinding under a sky full of stars, either cooking up your farm-fresh finds or indulging in a gourmet hamper from Valhalla.

DAY 2:

Lockyer Valley to Bunya Mountains 157kms

Start your morning with a delicious breakfast at Tins & Trays in Gatton before setting off for the Bunya Mountains (roughly a two-hour drive). On arrival, immerse yourself in this ancient landscape with a scenic



hike among towering Bunya pines. Check into a charming holiday home or chalet through Bunya Mountains Accommodation, then take in the sweeping views from Fishers Lookout. As the sun sets, head to Bunya Mountains Tavern for a hearty dinner, followed by a nightcap at Shackleton's Whisky Bar.

Overnight: Bunya Mountains Accommodation

DAY 3:

Bunya Mountains to Dalby 123km

Kickstart the day with breakfast at Poppies on the Hill, then make your way to the historic Jondaryan Woolshed. Explore one of the oldest working sheep stations in Australia with a guided tour. Continue to Jubri's Hideaway, a peaceful retreat just outside Dalby. Cool off with a refreshing dip in the pool before heading out for an afternoon wander through the stunning Jimbour House gardens (by appointment only). Enjoy a delicious meal back at Jubri's Hideaway (pre-order required).

Overnight: Jubri's Hideaway, Dalby

DAY 4:

Dalby to Miles back to Dalby 284kms

Travel west to Miles Historical Village, where you'll step back in time exploring heritage buildings, old schoolhouses, and fascinating historical machinery. On your way back to Dalby, stop in at the Dalby Saleyards, one of the largest livestock selling centres in the country, for an authentic glimpse into outback trade. Cap off the trip with dinner at The Bun Hotel in Kaimkillenbun before returning to Jubri's Hideaway for a final night of country tranquillity.

Overnight: Jubri's Hideaway, Dalby

DAY 5:

On your journey back to Brisbane via the Warrego Highway (approximately 1 hour and 50 minutes), pause in Toowoomba for a refreshing stroll through the lush Queen's Park. Then, savour a coffee or a hearty meal at one of the city's charming cafés or historic pubs.
